



FOCUS ON NIGERIA

leader of the Chris an Associ on of Nigeria (CAN) and pastor of a Brethren church, Lawan Andimi, was executed by Boko Haram terrorists on January 20th. Pastor Lawan was kidnapped during a raid in the town of Michika on January 3rd. Shortly

r, a video was released in which the pastor speaks of his faith in God's sovereignty despite the situ on. He told his family: "God is s Il alive.... Don't cry, don't worry, thank God for everything." News of his death also came via video, sent to the same journalist, showing the beheadings of Pastor Lawan and an unnamed soldier.

In response to the news, Floyd Brobbel, CEO for The Voice of the Martyrs, Canada, echoed the tes mony of Pastor Lawan by declaring: "His life was not wasted. What the enemy has meant for evil will be used for the Lord's glory. So while today we mourn, tomorrow we rejoice."

Three days of prayer and fas ng were declared by the Voice of the Martyrs Canada in response to the killing. A spokesperson stated they had done everything possible to secure the pastor's safe release. Without the support of the military, they had no further opons. The organiz on is urging the government to take all necessary steps to safeguard the lives of Nigerian Chris ans.

Please remember the family and friends of Pastor Lawan in the wake of this devasta ng news. Join with Chri ans throughout Nigeria who are mourning the loss of so many innocent lives and praying for peace and safety. Even in the midst of this tragic loss, we can thank God for the powerful mony of grace that was demonstrated through the life and words of Pastor Lawan. May the Lord use it to touch the hearts of people around the world, including the perpetrators of the crimes.

CALIFORNIA BILL COULD REQUIRE PLANNED PARENTHOOD PHONE NUMBER TO BE ADDED TO STUDENT IDS

California Demo lawmaker is denying that his bill requiring all student ID cards to include the phone number to a reproduc ve health care clinic, such as Planned Parenthood, would

only serve to promote abo n providers.

Last month, Assembly member Jesse Gabriel of San Fernando Valley introduced Assembly Bill 624, the "Pupil and Student Health" bill, that would require all middle schools, high schools and colleges — both public, private and Chris an schools — to carry student IDs with numbers to the N onal Sexual Assault Hotline, the Na onal Domes c Violence Hotline, and Planned Parenthood or another sexual health and abo n provider.

AB 624 has garnered cri cism from many pro-life advocates who say that, among other things, the bill

would force students to promote Planned Parenthood.

"By slapping Planned
Parenthood's hotline on the back
of every 12- to 24-year-old's ID,
California essen ally would be
forcing every student to join an
abo n sales team," said Tony
Perkins, president of the Family
Research Council in Washington,
D.C. "Gabriel's bill doesn't just
force young people to violate
their beliefs — it promotes an

industry that jeopardizes these girls' health," he added.

In a statement released Thursday, Gabriel disputed accus ons that his bill is an e rt to promote and adver se for abor n providers. He said the claims were "o sive, misleading, and at out wrong."

Gabriel was endorsed by Planned Parenthood Los Angeles and received a \$4,400 don on to his campaign last June.
