White Coat Syndrome

n case you aren't familiar with it, White Coat Syndrome is described as a phenomenon in which people exhibit a blood pressure level above the normal range in a clinical se g although they do not exhibit it in other

se gs. It is believed that the phenomenon is due to anxiety experienced during a doctor visit. So for some people merely seeing that white lab coat can create increased hypertension. I believe I experience white coat syndrome to an extent as well. My blood pressure always seems to be a li le higher at the doctor's office then when I take it at home, but my ques on is shouldn't there also be some type of syndrome where we are changed because we are in the presence of God?

According to the Bible, being in God's presence is a truly awesome and some mes absolutely terrifying thing. In Isaiah 6:1-5, Isaiah tells of his experience in

God's presence: "In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe—lled the temple. Above him were seraphs, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were—ying. And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was—ed with smoke. "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." It sounds like God's presence created much more than a slight increase in BP, in his own words- Isaiah was ruined.

Exodus 34 shows that, "When Moses nished speaking to them, he put a veil over his face. But whenever he entered the LORD's presence to speak with him, he removed the veil un I he came out. And when he came out and

told the Israelites what he had been commanded, they saw that his face was radiant. Then Moses would put the veil

back over his face un I he went in to speak with the LORD." The presence of God had a very real physical impact on Moses.

While we may not encounter God's presence in the same way as Isaiah and Moses, Hebrews 10:19-22 tells us, "Therefore, brothers, since we have con dence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure wa-

ter." We do have full access to God and we can enter with con dence.

I believe it is s II important to consider how God's presence should ect our life. If it doesn't we are living like an atheist. If merely the sight of a white coat can increase our blood pressure, how much more should the actual presence of God in our lives touch, disturb and move us?

he Kentucky Supreme Court dismissed a lawsuit against a Chris an business that refused on religious grounds to make T-shirts for a gay pride event. In *Lexington-Fay e Urban County Human Rights Commission v. Hands on Originals*, the state's highest court ruled unanimously last Thursday that the LGBT group suing the business did not have "statutory standing" to sue the company. The court noted that the local an -discrimin on ordinance only allowed for an individual complaint of discrimin on to be led, whereas the Gay and Lesbian Services Organiz on led the complaint as a group.
